#### **RETURNING TO CHURCH**

#### **Our Spiritual Guidelines:**

A lawyer once asked Jesus, "Teacher, which commandment is the greatest?" There is never a time in our life together when Jesus' answer isn't an important one for us. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and *first commandment...* and the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'" Jesus told his followers to follow these two instructions, and "hang all" they understood God to be and how to follow God more faithfully on these two spiritual practices. Love God and love one another.

In this first phase of returning to worship we are reminded worship, expressing our love for God, begins with opening our heart, soul and mind to the presence of a living God. Worshipping as a community is the purpose to our living as the Body of Christ in the world. But first, worship begins with our letting God, and each other, into our hearts, souls and minds...into our lives. That is why Jesus said the "second is like it," because for God these two are one in the same. Loving our neighbor is showing God our love. It will be important as we return to church that we stay mindful and compassionate of the people around us who are more vulnerable than ourselves. We have plans that will be important for all of us to consider in our hearts, souls and minds regarding the practice of good social distancing, wearing masks, and using plain common sense in doing our part to slow the spread of Covid-19.

#### Phase one reminder:

- We will return with "worship only" 8:30, 10:00 and 11:30 please register for a time.
- Usher will seat and assure proper social distancing six feet apart.
- You are encouraged to wear masks, but not required. Some will be provided.
- Please practice common sense personal hygiene, check temperatures regularly before attending worship, and please use hand sanitizers made available.
- The doors will be open to avoid touching door handles.
- Gathering and social time is encouraged before and after and outside in the open air.
- No coffee stations, food or beverages, or use of water fountains.
- No childcare at this time (Nursery, Sunday School, etc.)
- Adult Sunday Schools classes will continue to meet by Zoom or GoToMeeting, please be patient concerning any class time changes.
- If you are experiencing fever or symptoms of sickness: \*Please stay home\*
- Senior adults are advised to use wisdom and careful caution in making decisions to join us on Sundays.
- Offerings and gifts to the church will be collected in boxes positioned in Narthex and Gathering Space.
- Services will be livestreamed on our website at 10am.





We hope you will join us at beautiful Camp NaCoMe on Sunday, June 28 for a morning of outdoor worship, followed by lunch and fellowship. We will be practicing safe social distancing in the great outdoors! We will begin with our traditional cinnamon rolls and coffee at 9:30 AM. This year these will be set up outside, underneath a tent and refreshments will be served to you to prevent the spread of germs. We will gather in the open air chapel at 10:30 AM for worship, communion, and a Congregational Meeting to elect Ruling Elders and Deacons for the class of 2023. We encourage you to bring lawn chairs or blankets so that we can spread out on the grounds for our service. Following the service we will have picnic lunches, you are welcome to bring your own lunch or you may purchase a box lunch of fried chicken from the dining hall. The cost of lunch is \$11 for adults and \$7 for children 12 and under. We ask that you pay for your lunch in advance to prevent us from having to collect money onsite.
