As of year end 2019, we received 95% of our budgeted operating revenue, and spent 97.6%, of our budgeted operating expenses. This left us with a small deficit of approximately \$14,000 for the year. We received memorial gifts of approximately \$137,000, including donations for the establishment of the John Satterwhite Memorial Endowment Fund. We used approximately \$85,000 of memorial funds for capital improvements, including one new HVAC system and new sanctuary carpet. A second HVAC system was also installed, and paid for in January of 2020. A more detailed annual financial report will be presented to the congregation soon. 

The second Monday Circle will meet on February 10 at 10:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall.




